# Minutes: Heartland of Texas Emmaus Community Executive Board Meeting

April 4, 2022, 7:00 PM, Burnet FUMC

## Special guest: E.B. Reddoch

- 1. JoAnn called the meeting to order at 7:01 and Jason opened us in prayer.
- 2. March Minutes:
  - a. No changes were proposed.
  - b. Troy motioned to accept the March minutes. Mike seconded the motion. The vote to accept the minutes passed unanimously.
- 3. Treasurer's Report:
  - a. JoAnn's computer crashed (thankfully, not the weekend of the Walk), so the report didn't have its usual detail.
  - b. The Men's Walk expenses were  $\approx$  \$2,600, with  $\approx$  \$2,400 more for Eagle's Wings. The Walk more or less broke even.
  - c. The expenses did not include any costs for securing Burnet First UMC for Candlelight. The church doesn't charge HOTEC, but in the past, we have made \$100 donations. This has not happened since JoAnne has been treasurer. It is something to consider for the future.

#### 4. Ministry Manager:

- a. Allen has entered all the pilgrim and volunteer data from the Men's Walk into the Ministry Manager software platform. He's also entered them into a spreadsheet as a backup. There is a bug in the system and the IT support is located in Ukraine.
- b. Allen has secured our Upper Room number, so we can now order supplies.
- 5. Bylaws Committee Update:
  - a. The Bylaws Committee (Ti, Kelsey, and Mike) met during the past month and have drafted a proposal.
  - b. The current bylaws state that changes to the bylaws have to be read aloud at a meeting. However, this is not a simple change. It's a complete re-write.
  - c. Tom motioned that we suspense this rule. Kelsey seconded and the motion passed unanimously.
  - d. We will hold off on slotting people into 2 or 3 year terms for now, as this is addressed in the revised bylaws.
  - e. The revised bylaws must be approved by a ¾ majority of the board and then be presented to the community at large.

# 6. Board Positions:

- a. Treasurer:
  - Laura volunteered to assume the position of Treasurer and agreed to a 3 year term.
    Jason made a motion to nominate her. Troy seconded and the motion passed unanimously.
- b. North Coordinator:
  - i. Duties of a coordinator include:
    - 1. Securing a pastor for the monthly gathering.
    - 2. Procuring the juice and the bread for communion.
    - 3. Securing the musicians.
    - 4. Securing the 4<sup>th</sup> Day speaker.
    - 5. Emceeing the gathering.
    - 6. Set up and clean up for food.

- ii. Mary volunteered to be the North Coordinator. Tom made a motion to nominate her. Mike seconded and the motion passed unanimously.
- c. Assistant Lay Director:
  - i. Mike volunteered to be the Assistant Lay Director. Kelsey made a motion to nominate him. Robert seconded and the motion passed unanimously.
- d. With these 3 positions filled, all board positions are now filled!

#### 7. Other:

- a. JoAnn brought up something she heard and wanted to bring it to our attention so that we're all on the same page and it doesn't devolve into a situation like we experience a couple of years ago.
- b. She heard though the grapevine that the outside coordinator had to first be on the inside team.
- c. She did extensive research, including checking with the Upper Room, and wasn't able to substantiate that claim.
- d. This makes sense. Not everyone is comfortable working on the inside team and this shouldn't preclude them from serving and utilizing their gifts.

### 8. Closing remarks:

- a. Everyone is encouraged to read both the current bylaws (<u>click here</u> to view the current bylaws) and the proposed bylaws (hard copies were distributed, but will also be e-mailed to all board members).
- b. JoAnn expressed her heartfelt gratitude for all of the board members.
- 9. JoAnn adjourned the meeting at 7:55 and Troy closed us in prayer.
- 10. JoAnn immediately asked to re-convene the meeting to discuss the Lay Director for the Men's Walk 2023.
  - a. Russell Cochrane and David Hinojosa were considered.
  - b. Russell of the most ready.
  - c. Mike made a motion to nominate Russell as the Lay Director for the Men's Walk 2023. Tom seconded and the motion passed unanimously.
- 11. JoAnn re-adjourned the meeting.
