## Minutes: Heartland of Texas Emmaus Community Executive Board Meeting

September 6, 2022, 7:00 PM, Burnet FUMC

- 1. JoAnn called the meeting to order at 6:59 and Mike opened us in prayer.
- 2. June Minutes:
  - a. No changes were proposed.
  - b. Kelsey motioned to accept the June minutes, Troy seconded the motion, and it passed unanimously.
- 3. Treasurer's Report:
  - a. JoAnn distributed the treasurer's report for August.
  - b. The balance at the end of August was \$19,466.31.
  - c. Most of the Scholarship fund was moved to the General fund. \$3,000.00 remains in the Scholarship fund.
  - d. JoAnn doesn't remember the balance being as low as it is. Laura was traveling and wasn't available to ask.
- 4. Women's Walk update from Paula:
  - a. It is full 36 pilgrims.
  - b. Preparations are going well.
  - c. Kim has stepped down from the Music team. It's been in flux, but four people have stepped up.
  - d. If anyone is available to help with media, that would be great.
  - e. Agape is in good shape.
  - f. The Prayer Vigil is in need of people. Prayer warriors don't have to have been on a walk.
  - g. Mike will do the Candlelight music. The music will start at 7:30. The service will start at 8:00. The pilgrims will arrive around 9:00ish.
  - h. Jon Weems and Keith Russell will lead the service.
  - i. Golf carts:
    - i. Troy will bring his.
    - ii. Joe Neville usually brings his.
    - iii. We have rented them in the past.
    - iv. Allen will put out a note to the community.
  - j. Two vans have been reserved, but more are needed.
    - i. Hill Country Fellowship has provided a van in the past Bob will ask about it.
    - ii. Allen will ask Marble Falls UMC about theirs.
  - k. Servers are needed for the Saturday night meal. At least 10 in total are needed.
  - I. JoAnn has reserved First UMC for Candlelight. She will follow up to remind them.
- 5. A donation was sent to the Upper Room for the Men's Walk in the amount of \$25 per pilgrim.
- 6. Volunteers from various churches are being solicited for the Prayer Chapel. They do have to have been on a walk.
- 7. JoAnn will follow up on an order of about \$1,200 for Upper Room books.
- 8. Bylaws:
  - a. No feedback has been received from the community.
  - b. The bylaws were sent to the community on July 18. The 60-day period expires on September 18.
  - c. A document that provides details on the various committees needs to be drafted and kept on record so that the knowledge isn't lost as board members turn over.
    - i. This is separate from the bylaws and should not be included in the bylaws. It will include a list of committees and duties. Examples include registrar, golf carts, vans, etc.
    - ii. We are targeting doing this in the October/November timeframe.
- 9. Dates for future walks:
  - a. Men:

- i. April 20 to 23, 2023
- ii. April 18 to 20, 2024
- b. Women:
  - i. October 19 to 22, 2023 or October 26 to 29, 2023
  - ii. October 17 to 20, 2024 or October 24 to 27, 2024
  - iii. The dates are dependent on a UT college retreat. They get first choices in each of these years. We will take the other date.
- 10. New blood is needed in the community.
  - a. Sponsor training is needed. We will target a Fourth Day speaker for January or February who can address the topic and do it at both gatherings.
  - b. Troy commented that it's been like this for 30 years. Just get the word out and let the Holy Spirit work.
- 11. Kelsey closed us in prayer and JoAnn adjourned the meeting at 7:45.
