Minutes: Heartland of Texas Emmaus Community Executive Board Meeting

November 7, 2022, 7:00 PM, Burnet FUMC

- 1. JoAnn called the meeting to order at 7:02 and Jason opened us in prayer.
- 2. September Minutes:
 - a. No changes were proposed.
 - b. Troy motioned to accept the September minutes, Mike seconded the motion, and it passed unanimously.
- 3. Treasurer's Report:
 - a. When meeting the first Monday of the month, the report will be as of the prior month.
 - b. Women's Walk:
 - i. Income from the Women's Walk was \$8,600.
 - ii. Expenses were \$6,900.
 - 1. This doesn't include about \$4,000 paid to Eagle's Wings.
 - 2. They credited us \$1,900, which was deposited based on the anticipated attendance. They're process is to credit the deposit and then bill the full amount.
 - iii. Bottom line, the Walk broke even.
 - iv. Laura will adjust the scholarship fund based on scholarships applied.
 - c. There is \$27K in the bank, in a non-interest-bearing account.
 - i. There was a discussion around putting about \$3,000 into a CD.
 - ii. Based on current interest rates, we'd earn about \$30 every 6 months.
 - iii. This item was tabled until December.
 - d. Laura signed up for QuickBooks Online.
- 4. The report on the Women's Walk 2022 was postponed to December.
- 5. Eagle's Wings paved the paths with black asphalt, and they are now difficult to navigate at night.
 - a. We need a solution for future walks.
- 6. Men's Walk 2023:
 - a. Team meetings will start in January.
 - b. Russell will talk with Paul Allen, spiritual director.
 - c. Team members need to be assigned by December 1.
 - d. The board or a subset of the board can serve as the team selection committee.
- 7. Music for the community:
 - a. With Mike leaving, we need to fill that void.
 - b. Mario Martinez and his wife are a possibility.
 - c. Christine Robinson is a talented musician who might do gatherings and Women's Walks. Mike will talk to her.
 - d. We can probably bandaid it in the short term, but it's a big commitment.
 - e. The demand would be mitigated if we started having one gathering a month instead of two, switching between Marble Falls and Burnet.
 - f. There was a discussion around possibly having fewer than one gathering a month.
 - i. That could hinder any momentum the community might experience.
 - ii. The community is already losing momentum
- 8. Other:
 - a. There was a discussion around communications to the community.
 - i. Auto texts are a possibility.
 - ii. Communications should go out on Fridays instead of Mondays.
 - b. Perhaps gatherings should be rotated more to churches with active communities.
 - c. JoAnn will draft a 2023 calendar and e-mail it to the board. We can vote on it in December.

- d. We need to make sure we sign the covenant via Ministry Manager by April.
- e. People are allowed to fill more than one board position except for lay director, assistant lay director, and treasurer.
- f. The follow up discussion regarding the creation of documentation to memorialize the various positions for the inside and outside teams will be put on the December agenda.
- 9. Mike closed us in prayer and JoAnn adjourned the meeting at 8:12.
